



Supervision Fundamentals Certification

Workshop Requirements

Complete the five required workshops and one elective workshop. All workshops are a full-day.

Exams

After each required workshop, take a short online test to demonstrate comprehension of material.

Projects

Submit two Supervision projects for review. These projects will show benefit to a company by applying knowledge and techniques gained through coursework. The projects should focus on individual or team development. A manager from the company must sign them off.

Tools & Templates:

Templates are available online to help you apply the techniques learned.

Coaching

Phone coaching is available to help you apply what you have learned. We also offer a coaching session quarterly in our Training Center.

2019 Program Fees

The complete program fee includes required workshops, materials, tests, templates, and two project validations.
