Workshop Requirements

Complete the five required workshops and one elective workshop. All workshops are held in person.

Exams

After each required workshop, take a short online exam to demonstrate comprehension of material.

Projects

Submit two Lean projects for review. These projects will show measurable benefit to a company by applying knowledge and techniques gained through coursework. A manager and peer from the company must sign them off.

Tools & Templates

Templates are available online to help you apply the techniques learned.

Coaching

Coaching is available to help you apply what you have learned.

Program Fees

The program fee includes required workshops, exams, coaching, and two project evaluations.
