- No leadership involvement


## Building a foundation (Mindset Shift)



ECURIDATION .

- > Avoid blame & focus on growth
  - > See all problems as opportunities
- > Start small Small focus group with Change Champion
- Build System Track waste Align into your daily practice.
- > Teach & Mentor— provide a positive example of the transformation you seek. Be there by their side.
- Growth Opportunities
  - Always create situations for your team practice and discover their new mindset
- Always Celebrate Success!

## **Teach & Mentor**



## Highlights the wastes in a common process of making toast.

- ✓ Great examples of how many small changes can make a difference
- ✓ Emphasizes that all improvement comes from <u>direct observation</u>
- ✓ Highlights everything that gets in the way of the work
- ✓ All associates can relate to the example
- ✓ Process improves from 4 minutes to 2 minutes with some simple changes
- ✓ Immediately follow up with Waste walk of their own process.

### **Waste Training**



#### **Work Process**

#### **TRANSPORT**

Transporting materials to/from warehouse and production. Moving materials not required for processing.



#### **INVENTORY**

All raw materials or finished goods that are not being processed... just sitting there.



#### **MOTION**

People walking or moving more than is required to perform the given task. Multiple hand-offs. Workplace ergonomics.



#### WAITING

Idle time spent waiting for materials, tools, equipment, next step in the process.

#### **Everyday Life**

#### **TRANSPORT**

Setting the table for dinner. Hanging out the washing. Lighting the fire.



#### **INVENTORY**

Groceries and foodstuffs. Laundry and clothes. Fuel.

#### **MOTION**

Oven at floor level.
Painting a ceiling.
Books lying flat on a shelf.


#### WAITING

Dishwasher cycle. Kettle to boil. Immersion heater.

#### Pareto of Waste Recorded at cell / machine by the team




Reasons for missing Takt are listed on this chart Keeps team engaged in identifying waste

## Idea Board STAR Board (Saving Time & Resources)




## **Provide Growth Opportunities**


Expose the team to waste identification tools



Process / Value Stream Mapping




#### Spaghetti Diagram
