Data presented in this report is effective as of January 1, 2022.

Participating Organization Information

This year, 213 companies with a combined total of over 65,000 employ es substitted compensation and benefits data for the survey. The collective annualized compensation reflected in the survey report represents in excess of \$1.8 billion.

Annual Revenue

Participants were grouped into one of five revenue categories or dela activisis. The average annual revenue reported was \$192.3 million (median annual revenue of \$30.0 collion). These statistics exclude any companies reporting a \$0 revenue.

Participants were also asked to indicate over new unticipate gross revenues to change in 2022 compared to 2021. The majority of firms (71%) represented 2022 evenues will increase; 25% reported revenues will stay the same as 2021, and 4% reported they anticipate revenues in II decrease this year.

Number of Employees

Participants matched and report any-related data for 30,360 employees in 206 survey jobs. The median total employee headcount is 112.5 and the average is 307.9 (both figures higher than those reported in 2021, when the median was 107.0 and the average was 295.5).


