



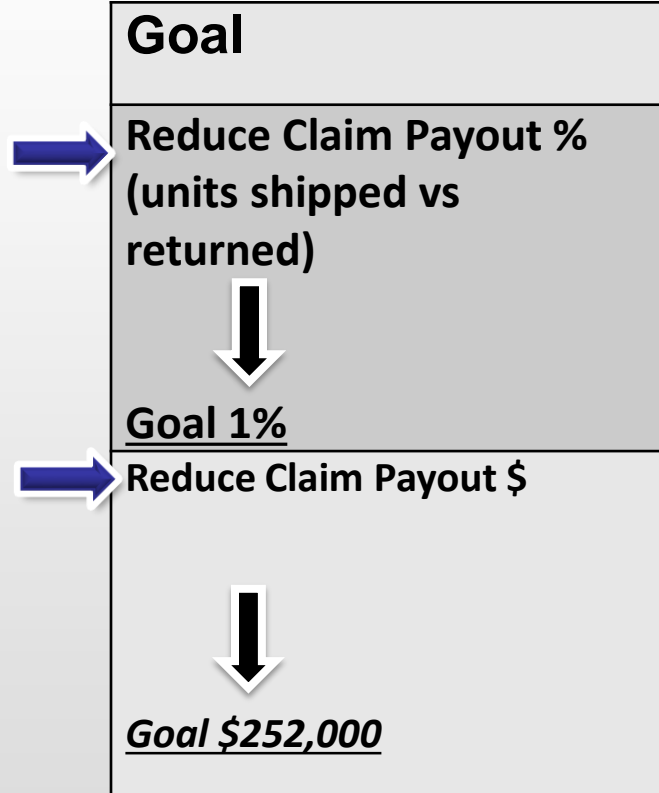
Current State

- Describes the starting point and baseline for the project.
 - What is the current performance (or lack thereof of the process)?
 - Describe the conditions along with the measures.
 - What issues does the situation cause?
 - Can include intangibles and behaviors
- Provides good context for help with sustainment

Goals & Results

Step 1 – Set Goals



- # of goals correlate to the problem statement objective

- Set *with* the team

→ Clear & Concise

→ Focus on the numbers

Step 2 – Current State

- Shows the measurement
- Provides the starting point

Step 3 – After Improvement

After
Q3 Warranty Claims
<u>.05% Claims</u>
Q3 Warranty Claim \$
<u>Actual: \$199,500</u>

- Shows the metrics after improvement
- Shows the change from current to future state

Results	
Reduced Claim Payout	
<u>Decreased 90%</u>	↓
Decreased Claim Payout	
<u>Reduced claims \$ by \$304,500 or 60.4%</u>	↓

- Use green for met goal
- Use red for didn't meet goal
- Use arrows to show increase or decrease
- Note: Words such as— improved, implemented, updated, enhanced, increased, decreased, etc. should **only** be used in conjunction with measurable data (% , \$, #'s)
