The purpose of your Participant Profile Report is to provide an "at a glance" sense of how competitive your base pay rates are. The design of the Participant Profile Report has been updated to provide more detailed and relevant information about your competitive pay position. In addition to comparisons with companies in your industry and geographic area, your Profile Report now features a new comparison to companies in your revenue size group. The colored icons which signal your level of competitiveness for each job in each section have been expanded to provide a more detailed visual gauge. More on this below.

Your company's reported base rate is shown for each job reported on your survey form. If you reported more than one incumbent in a job, the average rate is displayed. Be aware that some reported matches are removed during data review and validation if they appear to be incorrect or inappropriate.

The Survey column in the Same Industry, Same Area and Same Revenue Size sections shows you the average of what other survey participants in your industry, geographic area and revenue size group reported paying for the job. The Variance column indicates the percent by which your company's pay differs from the average, positively or negatively.

For some skilled trades positions, both local and industry comparisons may be important, so attention should be paid to both "Same Industry" and "Same Area" comparisons. Pay for leadership positions is typically sensitive to company scope, as measured by company revenues; for these positions, you may find the "Same Revenue Size" comparison to be critical. Your use of the information in this report should reflect careful consideration of your competitors for talent across all reported jobs.


